



ROLL UP DETAILS 2026 Season

- Formal roll up are held every Sunday morning from 10.00 am until c12.30pm with a break during for tea/coffee and biscuits. the session is currently run by Linda Brodie and teams/rinks will be allocated on the day depending on the number of attendees.
- Informal roll ups are held on a Thursday morning from 10.00am subject to weather and the number wanting to attend. if you are interested in playing on a Thursday morning speak to Linda Brodie who will put you on the relevant 'WhatsApp' which manages the sessions.
- The bowls club system shows all the recorded matches and will identify which are home games. members are free to come down to the bowls club anytime outside match times for a roll up but please bear in mind that play might not be possible as the green needs watering and cutting during the season and that there is no set schedule for this and is undertaken as and when required and is dictated by weather conditions.
- Members can come along for a roll up when they want (subject to the above) but the club does insist that a member does not come alone for health and safety reasons.
- To access the club there is a combination padlock on the main gate and the code to enter is shown here: [BCS Key Code Page](#)
- There is a combination padlock on the gate entrance to the green and again the code is shown here: [BCS Key Code Page](#)
- You will need to open the clubhouse in order to get the bowls shed key (this is hanging up by the notice board) to get jacks/mats etc. the clubhouse is accessed by keys which are in the combination lock on the post by the stairs. the combination is again shown here: [BCS Key Code Page](#). Please do not leave keys in the clubhouse as these are needed to lock the door.
- There will be a sign by the clubhouse indicating the direction of play on the green and also if there are any preferred or blocked rinks.
- If you use any of the kitchen facilities please ensure all cups etc are washed up and put away and all rubbish placed in the correct bin.
- Please ensure the keys to the clubhouse are placed back in the key box and all doors/gates are securely closed and locked.
