LEAGUE TEAM DETAILS FOR 2026 SEASON

DETAILED BELOW ARE THE LEAGUES AND TEAM DETAILS FOR THIS SEASON.

ALL MATCHES INCURE A £3 MATCH FEE PER PERSON.

MENS LEAGUE

- Generally played on a Thursday evening starting at 6.30pm although there are a couple of additional evenings in order to fulfil fixture requirements. Start times may vary in agreement with both captains taking account of light conditions
- Details of all matches and team selection are on the Bowls Club System (BCS)
- Games are played in accordance with English Bowls Association rules (full details on Bowls England web site) – your captain will ensure that you are provided with the basic rules and playing conditions.
- Matches are played over 18 ends and feature 4 teams on each side containing 4 players each with 2 bowls.
- The current Captain is Rob Dulstone.

LADIES LEAGUE

- Generally played on a Monday evening starting at 6.30pm. Start times may vary in agreement with both captains taking account of light conditions
- Details of all matches and team selection are on the BCS
- Games are played in accordance with English Bowls Federation rules (full details on Bowls England web site) – your captain will ensure that you are provided with the basic rules and playing conditions.
- Matches are played over 21 ends with 2 practice ends and feature 2 teams on each side containing 3 players each with 2 bowls.
- The current captain is Sarah Cook

OVER 60s LEAGUE (MILLICENT CHILDS LEAGUES)

- FBC has 2 teams entered in the leagues – these being a red team and a blue team comprised of men, ladies or mixed who are 60 years of age or over
- The Red team play in a higher league to the Blue Team. Players can nominate which team they would prefer to play in.
- Matches are played on a Wednesday afternoon starting at 2pm. Start times may vary in agreement with both captains taking account of light conditions
- Details of all matches and team selection are on the BCS
- Games are played in accordance with English Bowls Association rules (full details on Bowls England web site) – your captain will ensure that you are provided with the basic rules and playing conditions.
- Matches are played over 18 ends and feature 3 teams on each side containing 3 players each with 3 bowls.
- The current captains are Paolo Puddu – Red Team and Elaine Ward – Blue Team

CAMBRIDGE AND DISTRICT (C&D) LEAGUE

- FBC has entered 2 teams in the league.
- The first team currently plays in Division 1 and the second team in Division 4.
- Most games are played on a Tuesday evening but there are a few for both teams on a Fridays.
- Matches normally start at 6.30pm (6.15pm in August) but an earlier or later start can be agreed by both captains, taking account of light conditions.
- Details of all matches and team selection are on the BCS
- Games are played in accordance with the C&D Rules and details of these are contained within the C&D Handbook, a copy of which is kept in the Clubhouse, or on the C&D website (Google Cambridge and District Bowls). The captain will ensure that players are provided with the basic details before starting their first match.
- Matches are played over 18 ends and each match features 4 teams containing 3 players each with 3 bowls.
- The current captains are Ray Worsley – Division 1 and David Pask – Division 4

FRIENDLIES

- In 2026 there will be 6 friendly matches, and these will be played on either Friday or Saturday afternoons starting at 2pm. Start times may vary in agreement with both captains taking account of light conditions
- Details of all matches and team selection are on the BCS
- Games are played in accordance with English Bowls Federation rules (full details on Bowls England web site) – your captain will ensure that you are provided with the basic rules and playing conditions.
- Matches are played over 18 ends and feature a maximum of 4 teams on each side containing 3 players each with 3 bowls. Ends and number of teams may vary depending on numbers attending.
- The current captain is Penny Mills.

INDOOR / OUTDOOR LEAGUE

- This league is played indoors at the Huntingdon Indoor Bowls Club and is played on a Wednesday evening between 6.20pm and 8.15pm every week from around the middle of September to the end of April the following year.
- Fenstanton Bowls Club enter a team and playing is open to any member of the Club.
- The format is 4 players with 2 woods each and the only charge is a £4 rink fee.
- The current Captain is Gill Burgess.
